

Maes Elwy is a prime beat on the river Elwy noted for night-time sea trout fishing. It adjoins our Bryn Polyn beat which is downstream. The Association owns this beat, about 1100m right bank above and below the first weir on the Elwy. No fishing 27.4m above or 22.9m below weir.

Beat grid references, moving upstream:
Right Bank: SJ 04136 72542 to SJ 04038 71945

Parking is available at Bryn Polyn Nurseries and Maes Elwy Farm. (The latter is preferred due to difficult access from the Bryn Polyn bank). Turn into the entrance to MAES ELWY FARM - PRIVATE. There is a keypad entry lock code available from the Association secretary. Park on the grass verge on the left side between the two RASAAA signs. Walk along the drive, past the cattle grid and use the pedestrian field gate on the right. Keep left around the field boundary to the stile and steps at the corner of the woods. This access has been agreed to avoid crop damage. From the woods path walk to an obvious farm track which leads to a meadow and our new fishing access stiles.
